Dear Ms. Miller,

As you gather tonight with other Lake Washington School District parents to ask your school board to open your schools, please know that we, the undersigned state Senators, stand with you in solidarity. We know that Governor Inslee also has been pushing to get schools open, as have many leaders in the House of Representatives.

We know from the past year that being in classrooms is best for our children. The longer they are forced to receive most or all instruction remotely, the more they suffer academically, socially and emotionally. Like you, we also see adults and children spending time in other indoor settings, following accepted safety precautions, without apparent risk to their health. We see other schools in our state operating safely. We strongly believe your schools – and all Washington schools – can be opened safely NOW.

The lack of in-person instruction has become the leading equity issue of our time. Our state government has a constitutional duty to provide for the education of Washington children. They clearly are not receiving the quality instruction to which they're entitled.

The Legislature spent years pouring additional billions of dollars into education, and reforming K-12 funding to ensure that a child's educational opportunities would not depend on living in a certain ZIP code. That promise is being undermined. Kids are being needlessly left behind, and we fear it will permanently affect their lives.

It has been one year since our state was put under a state of emergency, and almost that long since schools were closed due to COVID-19. Meanwhile, most states have recognized the importance of returning students to their classrooms. Unfortunately, because of the decisions by many of our larger school districts, Washington ranks 47th in the country in getting kids back in school. Our children deserve better.

We appreciate the stand you are taking for your children. Today we stand with you, and with them. We hope your school board will too.
